Kurt Tidmore grew up in Texas and spent his summers on a ranch. At university he studied Economics and International Law, but was attracted away from them by photography and became the chief technical photographer for a major scientific and medical research institution. At the same time his personal photographs were regularly shown in galleries. In his mid-30s he gave up photography and began to write, first technical writing and advertising, then fiction, and received a Masters in Creative Writing at Lancaster University in the UK. After living in Europe for several years he moved back to the US where his first book Bigger'n Dallas was published. Since then he has worked as a book reviewer for the Washington Post and the Boston Globe, and as an editor for several national magazines. He now lives in Ireland with his wife.
